Fishes of North Inlet

Learn about fish, crab, and shrimp species common in our tidal creeks of North Inlet and assist with a long-term biological monitoring project. Participants will learn hands-on sampling methods in the salt marsh followed by a processing of the sample catch with the biologists in the seawater laboratory. Bring water, bagged lunch, insect repellent, and wear old sneakers/boots. **Cost: FREE; limited to 14 participants; please call to register.**
