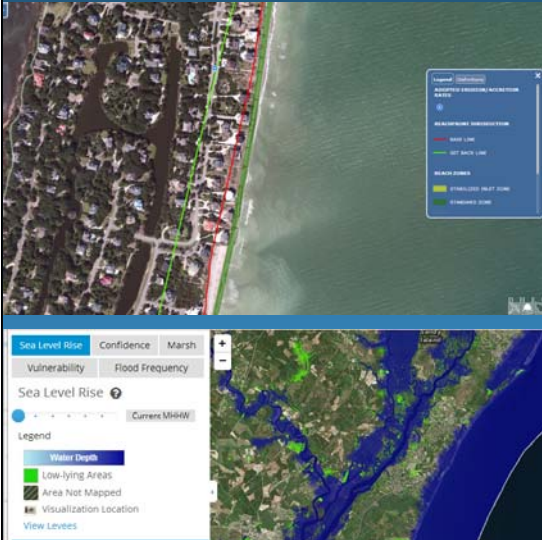


# COASTAL VULNERABILITY
